Institute Launches Corporate Vulnerability Index

SINGAPORE, July 12 (Bernama) -- The Risk Management Institute (RMI) at the National University of Singapore (NUS) has launched the Corporate Vulnerability Index (CVI).

In a statement, the NUS said the indices would be updated on a daily basis and were available for free at www.rmicri.org, providing timely indicators of the corporate credit risk environment.

"This is a new series of indices that are indicators of credit risk in different regions, economies and portfolios," it said.

Prof Duan Jin-Chuan, director of NUS RMI and Cycle & Carriage Professor of Finance at NUS, said in view of the uncertainty in the global economy, the CVI could be used by the media, the financial industry and academia in their assessment of the economic environment.
